1 Introduction

2 New features and fixes

- Addition of separate FTP publish of media to a media server.
- Addition of an URL tour capability as a slide property. User can specify any URL, or can specify a filename such as a Word doc, PDF file, Flash file, etc. User can specify the location, and size of the window, as well as the name of the frame.
- Added ability to move slides forward and backward in order
- Added ability to view larger slide images while recording slide timing. Slides can even be displayed full screen.
- sofTV.Presenter 2.1 now remembers Video URL and Publish Point settings. It remembers all FTP settings and local publish settings. All settings are stored in the registry.
- sofTV.Presenter 2.1 now remove spaces from PPT filename when imported into sofTV.Presenter 2.1
- Addition separate fields for Record New filename and Use existing filename, and remember whether I have selected "Use an existing file" for "Record a New File"
- Fix of bug where Live Encoder dialog Live Encoder settings were disabled if "Use Existing File" was selected previously in VOD Encoder dialog.
